Working of Up Trains at Brynglas

Road Crossing

When there is a Blockman or other competent person present on the ground to watch for (and if necessary warn) approaching road traffic, up trains need not stop before crossing the road.

Otherwise:

- a) Locomotives, Motor Trolleys or other self-propelled vehicles *either* light, *or* coupled to one bogie or one/two four-wheeled vehicles, must STOP before crossing the road.
- b) Other trains need not stop before crossing.

Working to the Platform

Trains are permitted to proceed into the Platform as far as the Up Limit of Shunt Board without first obtaining a Brynglas-Quarry Token, and should do so when operational requirements indicate (e.g. for a passenger train to set down or pick up passengers, or for an engineering train to shunt into the loop via the east points).
