Positioning of Saloons

The following procedures must be followed for trains where the saloon double doors are off the platform while the locomotive runs round at Wharf.

Up Trains

The train must be set back in the platform as soon as practicable unless the Platform Inspector is certain that no passenger in a wheelchair will arrive before departure.

Down Trains

- a) If there is a passenger in a wheelchair in the saloon, the Guard must advise the Driver *privately* when notifying which intermediate request stops are required.
- b) The train must run to the buffer stop on arrival at Wharf to allow the passenger to alight.
